Follow-Up and Fellows Meeting «Science in Pharmacy, Pharmacy in Science»

• Background, Aims:

The current discussion on the role of the pharmacist in the health care system is demanding a shift from being a producer and supplier of therapeutics towards a more poignant patient-centric, "clinical" function. Following a roundtable, organized by the SAPhS in Bern on August 30, 2016, on the currently ongoing reforms at the University of Basel, Geneva and the ETH Zurich ([1], report attached), we would now like to analyse whether the present curricula are ready to provide the scientific basis needed for this role. Secondly, we would like to discuss potential new fields of activity for the public pharmacist, e.g., in personalized therapy and individualized drug formulation [2]. These discussions will need the contribution of pharmaceutical scientists from all walks of life. The outcome will again be published in the form of an opinion paper.
