## Education

### **APhWS «Ausbildung Pharmazeutische Wissenschaften Schweiz, APhWS» (Formation Sciences Pharmaceutiques Suisse, FSPhS; Education Pharmaceutical Sciences Switzerland, EPhSS)**

- APhWS is a committee managed by SAPHs. All Swiss Schools of Pharmacy, as well as pharmaSuisse are represented. APhWS is chaired by Dr. Christine Moll (vice-president SAPHs).
- APhWS is working on several documents in preparation for the third version of the Swiss learning objectives catalog for studies in pharmacy released by the Swiss Federal Office of Public Health. The learning objectives mentioned in the catalog will be adapted in accordance with the evolution of the pharmacist's profession and responsibilities as an actor in public health.
- The following documents are currently in progress:
  - Document 1: Matrix inventory of learning content on NCD in basic training at all Swiss Schools of Pharmacy.
  - Document 2: Consultation situations acute and/or chronic. The B+ list has also been added there. Consensus among sites is very important here.
  - Document 3: Exchange on teaching «Pharmaceutical and Clinical Skills» in the Master's phase of the Pharmacy curriculum.
- Regular meetings are held.
- APhWS structure and membership allows for the inventarisation of topics currently taught at the different sites, which will be followed by an alignment and harmonization across Switzerland.
