The second cohort of students in year 4 successfully completed their Master theses in summer 2022. Again, we could reward an outstanding Master thesis with the GSIA Master Thesis Award. Jocham presented the award to Jana Schelshorn for her Master thesis entitled «Evaluation of a drug therapy safety algorithm for the detection of Triple Whammy prescriptions in inpatients at risk of acute kidney injury».

In summer 2022, all students in year 5 successfully completed the first Master course in Pharmacy and received the degree Master of Science in Pharmacy. In September 2022, the first federal exams in pharmacy took place in Bern, and 22 young pharmacists have achieved the federal diploma. Congratulations!

University of Geneva

<u>Jean-Luc Veuthey</u>, professor in pharmaceutical sciences, will retire at the end of July of this year. Besides being a renowned expert in his field of research and an excellent teacher, Prof. Veuthey has served at the highest levels of administration of the University of Geneva as vice-rector, vice dean and as president of the Section of Pharmaceutical Sciences.

In the framework of the Institute of Pharmaceutical Sciences of Western Switzerland (ISPSO), the Centre for Research and Innovation in Pharmaceutical Sciences (CRISP) at the University of Lausanne is establishing a chair in digital pharmacy. The future chair will build a research and teaching interaction network in the field of digital pharmacy between the University of Geneva, the University of Lausanne, the Energypolis campus and the hospitals of the canton of Valais.

Kristallmagie – Verborgener Zauber dunkler Turmaline

Turmaline sind nicht nur begehrte Schmucksteine, sondern auch spannende Studienobjekte. Während bunte Varianten selten und kostbar sind, kommen äußerlich pechschwarze Turmaline häufig vor – mitunter auch im Schwarzwald. Sie wirken zunächst unscheinbar, halten aber eine faszinierende Überraschung bereit: Schneidet man die Kristalle in Scheiben und schleift diese hauchdünn, tauchen aus dem Dunkel Farben und manchmal auch unglaubliche Bildwelten auf. Solche eindrucksvollen Kunstwerke der Natur entstehen, weil Turmaline während ihres Wachstums sehr sensibel auf äußere Einflüsse reagieren. Sie ändern dabei ihre Form und Farbe.

«Ausbildung Pharmazeutische Wissenschaften Schweiz, APhWS» (Formation Sciences Pharmaceutiques Suisse, FSPhS; Eduction Pharmaceutical Sciences Switzerland, EPhSS)

All university locations as well as pharmaSuisse and the SAPhS are represented in the APhWS. It is chaired by Dr. Christine Moll (Vice-President of SAPhS). At the suggestion of pharmaSuisse, the miniPAP («Pharmacy Education Platform») has been the responsibility of the SAPhS since 2020. On 24 November 2020, the miniPAP was renamed APhWS (Ausbildung Pharmazeutische Wissenschaften Schweiz; Formation Sciences Pharmaceutiques Suisse, FSPhS; Eduction Pharmaceutical Sciences Switzerland, EPhSS). All meetings are moderated by Dr. Christine Moll. All four training sites are represented, as well as colleagues of pharmaSuisse and hospital pharmacy, and members of the SAPhS Senate's Board. Topics discussed included: Implementation of new curricula, in particular the new competences vaccination, diagnosis and therapy; learning objectives catalogues preparation for version 3 for the Federal Pharmacy Examinations; demarcation of training from continuing education as well as the role and positions of the Master Universities.

Conference Report of 15th SPhSD 2022

After the cancelled SPhSD 2020, due to the pandemic, and the virtual SPhSD 2021 this year's SPhSD could again be performed in the physical presence mode. Since 2008 the SPhSD has been situated at the Bern University Hospital (Inselspital) and now for the first time at the new Von Roll Campus of the University of Bern. Four distinguished speakers with different backgrounds presented their research and perspectives to the general conference topic *«Immunology»*. In between the lecture sessions, 59 posters were exhibited by young academics debating exciting data out of the main pharmaceutical research areas. Again, 6 posters could be awarded one of the appreciated sponsored poster prizes. As for the first time in 2019, the afternoon session included 15-min oral presentations of 4 selected poster abstracts, offering young scientists the opportunity to also present their work in the audience hall. Appreciated by the organizers, the online evaluation of the FPH-accredited event showed an average overall rating of 3.5 (max. 4).
