



Online Swiss Pharma Science Day 2021 3rd Announcement, Last Call for Registration and Abstracts

Dear Colleagues,

- ❖ **Less than 6 weeks** before the most important annual SAPhW event and **2 weeks before the deadline for poster abstract submission** I would like to remind you of the 14th Swiss Pharma Science Day (SPhSD), this year taking place virtually by **Zoom video conference on Wednesday 25 August 2021, 10:00 to 16:30**. This year's topic focuses on «**Precision Medicine**».

- **The strict deadline for submitting poster abstracts is set to July 31, 2021**. For standardized formatting see p. 6 of the program. As usual, all abstracts will be published in the conference booklet, which will be available on our website for pdf download shortly before the event.
- **e-Posters** require a standardized format (see attached template) and can be visited during the poster session via special break room gallery. Again, **6 prizes** will be awarded. However, a representative evaluation requires a minimum number of submissions. Three award winners (1st prize, best poster in pharm. technology and pharm. biology/phytopharmacology) are offered a live platform for also shortly presenting their work orally. Based on the presented research topic e-posters will be attributed to sub-groups, facilitating the visit of the gallery and the work of reviewers.
- **Certificates of attendance**, required for claiming FPH credits, **and of poster presentations** will be issued after the event. **Evaluation forms** will be included in the conference booklet.
- At given time a **Zoom access** code is sent to all registered participants.
- **Fees:** Participation is **free for SAPhS members** plus academics, employees and students of universities with collective membership (Univ. BS, GE, BE, ETHZ, FHNW). For non-members the fee is CHF 150.00, 50.00 for students of non-member institutions.

Please further promote the SPhSD 2021 within your institution, among co-workers, and on your websites.
