



Swiss Pharma Science Day 2022 2nd Announcement, Call for Registration and Abstracts

Dear Colleagues,

- **Less than 3 months** before the most important annual SAPhW event the Organizing Committee would like to remind you of the 15th Swiss Pharma Science Day (SPhSD), this year taking place physically **on Friday 19 August at the University of Bern Von Roll Campus**.
- Please find attached the final program. This year's topic focuses on «**Immunology**».
- **The strict deadline for submitting poster abstracts is set to 31 July 2022**. For formatting see p. 6 of the program. As usual, all abstracts will be published in the conference booklet, which will be available on the SAPhS website shortly before the event.
- **Posters** require a standardized A0 landscape format and template (see program p. 6 and [SPhSD website](#)). Again, **6 prizes** will be awarded. However, a representative evaluation requires a minimum number of submissions. Four poster presenters, evaluated in advance by the reviewer board, are offered a platform for also shortly discussing their work orally. Based on the presented research topic posters will again be attributed to sub-groups.
- **Certificates of attendance**, required for claiming FPH credits, **and of poster presentation** will be available at the front desk. **Evaluation forms** can be found in the conference booklet.
- **Registration:** please register [online](#) a.s.a.p. to facilitate organization.
- **Fees:** For SAPhS members plus academics, employees and students of universities with collective membership (Univ. BS, GE, BE, ETHZ, FHNW) the early bird fee is CHF 70.00, for non-members CHF 150.00. In case of late registration (after July 31) or onsite payment the fees are CHF 100.00 and 200.00, respectively.
