



Swiss Pharma Science Day 2022 3rd Announcement, Call for Registration and Abstracts

Dear Colleagues,

- **Less than 1 month** before the most important annual SAPhW event the Organizing Committee would like to remind you of the 15th Swiss Pharma Science Day (SPhSD), this year taking place physically **on Friday 19 August at the University of Bern Von Roll Campus**.
- This year's topic focuses on «**Immunology**». For program see [SPhSD website](#).
- **The strict deadline for submitting poster abstracts is set to 31 July 2022**. For formatting see the [SPhSD website](#). As usual, all abstracts will be published in the conference booklet, which can be downloaded as pdf on the SAPhS website shortly before the event. A printed version will not be distributed.
- **Posters** require a standardized A0 landscape format and template (see [SPhSD website](#)). Again, 6 prizes will be awarded. However, a representative evaluation requires a minimum number of 40 submissions. Four poster presenters, evaluated in advance by the reviewer board, are offered a 15-min platform for also shortly discussing their work orally. Based on the presented research topic posters will be attributed to sub-groups.
- **Certificates of attendance and poster presentation** will be sent by e-mail after the event.

- **Fees:** For SAPhS members plus academics, employees and students of universities with collective membership (Univ. BS, GE, BE, ETHZ, FHNW) the **early bird (until 31 July 2022) fee** is CHF 70.00, for non-members CHF 150.00. In case of late registration (after July 31) or onsite payment the fees are CHF 100.00 and 200.00, respectively.
