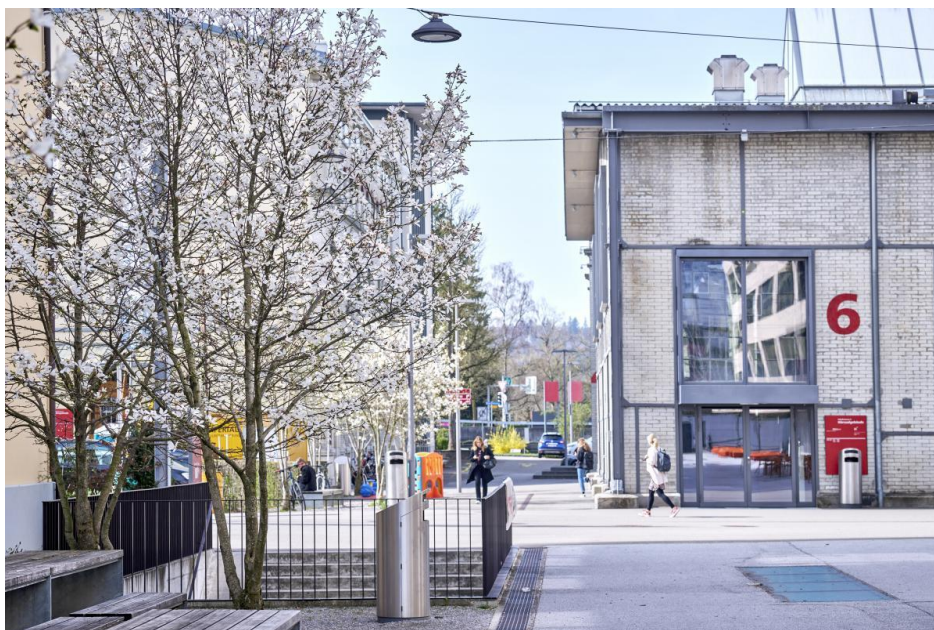

# Welcome

The SWISS PHARMA SCIENCE DAY (SPhSD) is an annual event of the Swiss Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences (SAPhS, [www.saphw.ch](http://www.saphw.ch)). It offers a unique platform for scientists in the field of pharmaceutical sciences to meet, interact and learn.

The 19th SPhSD is placed under the theme of «*Women's Health and Gender Medicine*». The World Health Organization states that achieving global health goals faces major hurdles, and progress will only occur if women's health is prioritized, adequately funded, and given visibility.

As in previous years, MSc and PhD students, and post-doctoral scientists will have the opportunity to present their latest research in a poster session, and three abstracts will be selected for short oral presentations. The best abstracts for posters will be selected for flash poster talks. A panel discussion will enable a deeper conversation on the central theme of the SPhSD 2026. The scientific part will be followed by the award ceremony and a final, traditional Apéro.

One of the primary goals of the SPhSD is to promote professional and social contacts between students, postdocs, and established scientists in academia, industry, hospitals, public health administration, and public pharmacies. For students and young scientists, the SPhSD offers a unique platform to explore opportunities and career paths across various professional fields. Established scientists can meet young scientists who may be recruited for a position in their organisation. This will be facilitated by the newly introduced “*Career Corner*” and “*Innovation Corner*”.

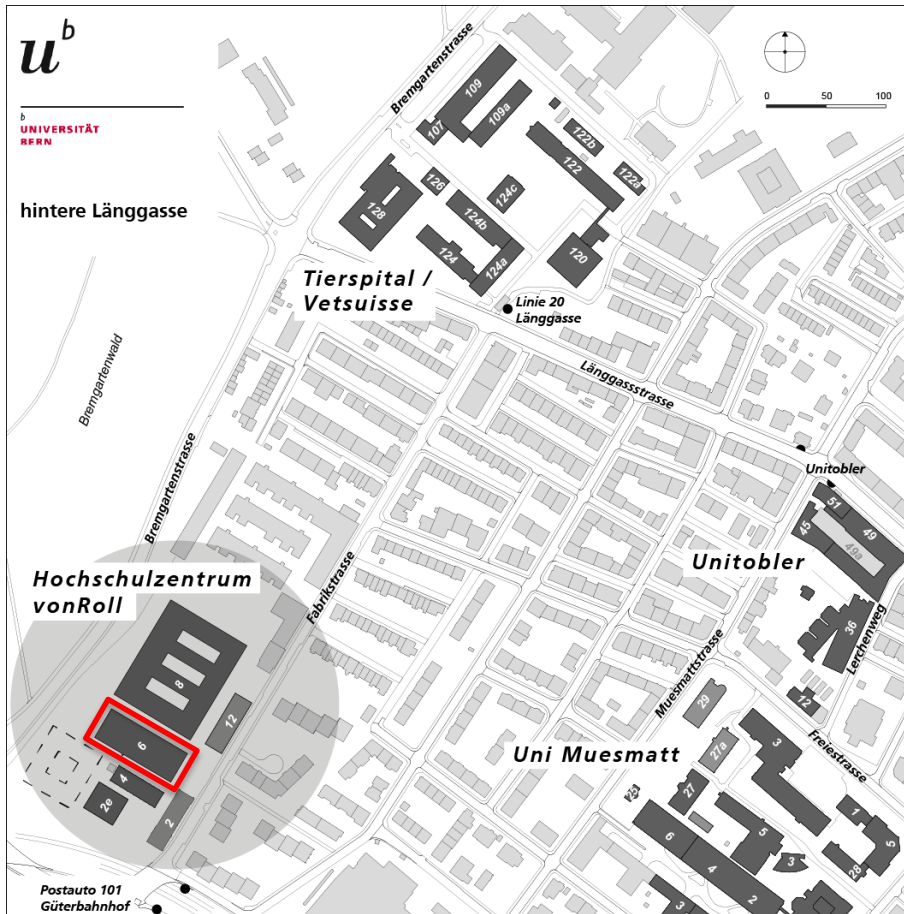
